

## Eligibility criteria for breast reduction allowance

Southern Cross will only reimburse the allowance for a breast reduction under a member's policy on acceptance of a medical report supplied by the operating surgeon that demonstrates criteria 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 below are met for that member.

- 1. At least two of the following symptoms have been present for a minimum of 12 months:
  - pain in the upper back, neck or shoulders
  - headaches (secondary to neck or back pain)
  - pain / discomfort / ulceration from bra straps cutting into shoulders (not just imprints of straps)
  - associated skin disorders unresponsive to conservative medical treatment.
- 2. Medical examination confirms macromastia.
- **3.** Bra cup size is over DD.
- **4.** The amount of breast tissue to be removed is estimated to be at least 350 grams per breast.
- **5.** If the patient is over 30 years, there were no suspicious lesions found on a mammogram completed within 12 months of the date of surgery.

The allowance for a breast reduction will not be reimbursed in the following circumstance:

• for breast reduction via tumescent liposuction.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
