

Eligibility criteria for insertion or removal of an intrauterine device

Southern Cross will only reimburse the <u>cost of insertion or removal</u> of an intrauterine device under a member's policy when at least **one** of the following criteria below is met for that member.

- 1. The member has symptoms of menorrhagia or dysmenorrhoea.
- 2. An endometrial biopsy demonstrates evidence of endometrial hyperplasia.

Southern Cross will not reimburse the cost of the intrauterine device.

The cost of the insertion or removal will **not** be reimbursed in the following circumstances:

- if used solely for contraception
- if used for the treatment of fibroids
- if used for the treatment of endometrial polyps
- if used for the treatment of post-coital bleeding
- if used as part of hormone replacement therapy.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.

Refer to the relevant policy document for specific conditions and exceptions that apply to these exclusions.
