

## Eligibility criteria for cone beam computed tomography (CBCT)

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) under a member's policy when at least **one** of the following criteria is met for that member:

- 1. For the assessment of impacted teeth.
- **2.** For the assessment of complex third molar anatomy.
- 3. For the assessment of oral pathology.
- **4.** For the assessment of temporomandibular joint (TMJ) disease or disorders.
- **5.** For the assessment of sinus disease.
- **6.** For the assessment of temporal or skull bones.
- 7. In preparation for image guided surgery.

The cost of the cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) will **not** be reimbursed in the following circumstances:

- for assessment for pre-implant planning
- for orthognathic or orthodontic evaluation
- for the assessment of developmental or congenital facial skeleton deformities.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
