

Eligibility criteria for liposuction for secondary lymphoedema following an oncological intervention

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of liposuction for secondary lymphoedema following an oncological intervention under a member's policy when criteria **1**, **2**, **3**, and **4** are met for that member.

- **1.** The member must have secondary lymphoedema because of a primary non-skin related oncological treatment.
- **2.** The member has failed conservative therapy including 3 months or more of compression therapy.
- **3.** The member's case must have multidisciplinary team input confirming agreement to liposuction.
- 4. At least one of the following is present:
 - hospitalisation directly related to complications of lymphoedema
 - recurrent ulcerations requiring antibiotic treatments
 - documented significant impairment of activities of daily living.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
