

## Eligibility criteria for the removal of exostoses

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of the removal of exostoses under a member's policy when **at least one** of the following indications are present, with reasons provided in the clinical notes.

- 1. A reduction in external auditory canal dimensions to the point of water trapping post immersion.
- 2. Recurrent ear canal infections or the treatment of infections compromised by existing canal dimensions.
- 3. As a necessary adjunct to the effective management of other canal pathologies for example: canal cholesteatoma, erosive otitis externa.
- 4. A required component of another operative process where its inclusion will add incremental benefit eg tympanoplasty, atticotomy, tympanomastoid surgery.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
