

Eligibility criteria for laparoscopic renal cryotherapy

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of laparoscopic renal cryotherapy under a member's policy when criteria **1**, **2**, **3**, **4**, **5** and **6** below are all met for that member.

- 1. The member has been diagnosed with renal cell carcinoma (RCC).
- **2.** The cancer(s) are localised to the kidney.
- 3. There are no regional lymph node metastases.
- 4. There are no distant metastases.
- **5.** The tumour(s) being treated is 4cm or less in size.
- **6.** At least **one** of the following applies:
 - the member has a single kidney
 - the member has chronic renal failure
 - the member has bilateral renal disease (ie von Hippel-Lindau disease), or
 - a partial nephrectomy (laparoscopic or open) is not considered safe or appropriate.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.

Refer to the relevant policy document for specific conditions and exceptions that apply to these exclusions.
